- We have helped the church on the ground give some food support to starving refugees arriving in the area.

- **Update on Longar:** Longar is working at the airport in Juba. He has been given a lot of responsibility in management and is gaining a lot of good experience even though getting paid by the government is hit or miss.

Following are challenges we are facing as we head into 2026. We will need your prayers and support to address these.

- Strain on medical and food supplies as refugees continue to stream down due to intense fighting in Khartoum and especially the Darfur region.
- We need to expand the clinic and increase our food support and equipment for the school.

Following are upcoming travel and ministry plans. We invite your prayer coverage as Scott and Fran prepare for this ministry.

- Scott Thompson will be traveling to South Sudan in late January to hold a conference for traumatized pastors and their wives. He'll be partnering with pastor Paul Lueth and his wife, Regina.
- Fran will be traveling to Kenya in February to work with the women and children in the South Sudanese refugee community in Nakuru.
