It is the rainy season in South Sudan and flooding is taking place in our region. Rising river water is near our compound, but our children are safe so far. Please pray that it will not reach our orphanage and clinic compound.

Pastor Matthew does not let weather or country instability slow him down in his evangelistic crusades. He is currently preparing to lead a crusade in Egypt where he spent time as a young man escaping the war in South Sudan. When the South Sudanese were persecuted in Egypt, Matthew along with many others fled to Israel where he studied at a Messianic Bible College. After 7 years in Israel, the South Sudanese were ordered to leave. Now a powerful Evangelist, Matthew's life has come full circle.



We were also so happy to receive reports that some of the women we trained in our healing and reconciliation workshop in the Sudanese refugee community in Nakuru Kenya have been sharing what they learned. They are visiting families and praying for the sick. They are also meeting and praying with members of warring tribes from South Sudan and building pathways to reconciliation. We hope to hold another healing and reconciliation workshop in Nakuru Kenya with the Sudanese refugees in the next few months.



Pastor Paul and Pastor Philip led a church leaders training and encouragement meeting we recently funded. They are in the process of constructing another church building after their's was burned to the ground by an opposing tribe. I asked Pastor Paul, who had been through our healing and reconciliation workshop, if he thought there was a chance that the new structure might also be destroyed. He said "No, we led the leader to the Lord, and he is attending our church."



Our student Michael, who started with our orphanage as a boy, is now in his third year of medical school and just finished his practical training in a hospital in Aweil. Michael also volunteered some of his time at our clinic and orphanage in Akuak Rak. What a joy it is to see the progress of Michael's studies and see the hope of a bright future.
